We are proud to provide services such as WIFI, cell towers, dump stations, parts, supplies and propane. Our RV Park is kept secure with perimeter fencing, gates, cameras and overnight security.

There are nearly 400 full hook-up sites and plenty of space for dry camping. Our sites can accommodate big rigs, tour buses, clubs and rallies! The RV PARK at the Pima County Fairgrounds includes both indoor and outdoor rental facilities to host trade shows, conferences, concerts, training and educational experiences.

Along with several RV shows per year, the RV Park at the Pima County Fairgrounds has hosted several major rallies including Escapees, FMCA, Tiffin/Allegro, RMMA and many other regional chapters. Our sites are competitively priced at \$52 per night. We remain open year-round with some limitations during the month of April.
